Subject: RCGA Network powered by Golf Intelligence

Season Greetings and best wishes in 2006 to everyone from the board and staff of the British Columbia Golf Association.

We have been asked to clarify the pricing of the RCGA Network system powered by Golf Intelligence. For those clubs who were part of the BCGA Network provided by Jencess the cost of the new system is the same as the old system. It is a per member fee of \$3.00. That means that membership in the association as an adult will be \$22.00 plus \$3.00 to belong to the network for a total fee of \$25.00. Juniors would be \$24.00.

Several clubs who were not on the Jencess system have joined the new network after seeing the demonstration. The cost for these clubs will also be \$3.00 per member that will be added to the per member cost of membership in the association. The new clubs joining have indicated that they see the value added of the new system.

The only other cost associated with the system is the cost of providing high speed continuous internet access whether by cable or telephone line. In most clubs this should be nominal as it only means networking the handicap computer to an existing internet connection. The hardware requirements are less than what is required to run current programs so this should not be a cost to the clubs.

To see the capabilities of the program clubs are invited to go online to www.golfintelligence.com/rcga/login/ . This will bring you to the Login Page. The Username is rcgadem0 plus any number from 1 to 50. As an example rcgadem023 or rcgadem047. The password is the same as the username. If you cannot login you may be trying to access the system at the same time as someone else who is logged in with the username. Just try another username. Please do not edit any fields in this demo site. We are in the process of converting to Canadian content.

We are pleased by the comments of the clubs who have seen the demonstration. They have been universal in telling us they see the potential in the system and consider it a great benefit to their membership. We demonstrated the system to the Allied Golf Association members last Friday and they all indicated that they saw how the system could be beneficial and how it could make members feel more connected to the game.

The Allied Golf Association is comprised of representatives of the BC Professional Golf Association, the National Golf Course Owners Association, The Club Managers Association, The BC Golf Superintendents Association and the BCGA. The Allied Golf Association meets to see how as an industry all the Associations can work together to grow the game of golf.
