DOROTHY OLIVE FRANKLIN MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT

This Provincial Tournament was established in honour of the late Dorothy Olive Franklin who gave a great many years to ladies' golf, both at the Provincial and National level.

The proceeds are used to help send promising Junior Girls to out-of-province or international tournaments. This Tournament is held at the Club level in the month of June and is open to any female golfer with an established Golf Canada handicap factor (maximum 54.0). An award is presented to all of the Zone winners. The BC Office determines the Provincial winner.

FEE: \$2.00 per participant.

BEAT THE CHAMP - JUNIOR GOLF WEEK

Junior Golf Week is a worthwhile program and is an important source of funds for carrying out an active program both at the Club and Zone levels for junior girls.

BEAT THE CHAMP! Players' net differential in relation to the Champion's lowest gross differential score posted at the prior year's BC Women's Amateur Championship.

FEE: \$1.00 per round per person - enter as many times as you wish.

Member Club retains 60% of the revenue from Junior Golf Week for its own Junior Development Program and sends 40% to the **Zone Chair**. If you are a Club without juniors, please forward the full amount to the Zone Chair.

BC ZONE NET TOURNAMENT

(Formerly known as the BC Mid-Amateur Tournament or the National Handicap Award Tournament)

This competition is an 18-hole stroke play, optional tournament for mid-handicap players, played at the Zone level. A provincial winner is determined by comparing the net handicap differentials of all the Zone winners.

BC PIN ROUND COMPETITION

This is a provincially sponsored stroke play competition. The Club winner is the player with the single lowest net score from rounds played. Zone Chairs will determine the Zone winners. An award is presented to both the 9-hole and 18-hole Club and Zone winners. The Provincial Award is presented to the lowest Net Handicap Differential of all the Zone winners for the 18-hole competition.

Proceeds from this competition go towards junior girls and women's player development programs.

FEE: \$2.00 per participant per season
